

Historic District Plaques

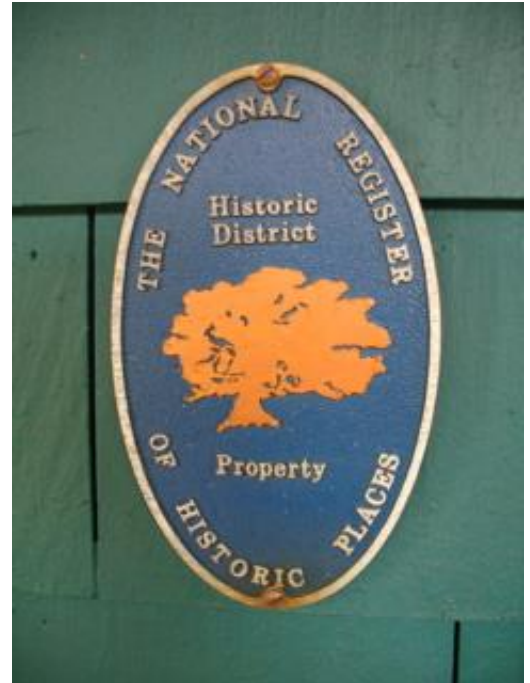
Hartford's West End is a wonderful collection of homes with historical significance. Most of the properties are included in one of the many historic districts that are recognized on both a state and national level. Please read on to learn how to get a Historic District plaque for your home.

Historic District Plaques are available through the Historic Preservation & Museum division of the Connecticut Commission on Culture & Tourism. Use the following steps to get a Historic District plaque.

1. Determine if your property is in one of the Historic districts, and if so, which district using the address list on the second page of this flier.
2. Call the Commission on Culture & Tourism's Historic Preservation & Museum Division at 860-256-2800 and tell them that you would like to purchase a Historic District Property plaque. The Commission will mail you a form to complete (it's a postcard).
3. Complete the postcard form once it arrives and write a check for \$35 payable to "Treasurer, State of CT."
4. Mail both the completed postcard and the check in a single envelope to :

The Commission will mail the plaque and notes that it can take up to six weeks for delivery.

Those able to visit the Commission's office in person can complete the form, pay in person, and receive their plaque immediately (pending availability). The office is located at the address in step 4; call the number in step 2 for current hours.
